With an Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic plan, you're at the center.

You get a special network of Cleveland Clinic doctors, specialists and hospitals focused on you. With the support of data and analytics,* this care team works together to help you stay well, so you can reach your personal health care goals, reduce duplicate tests and avoid trips to the emergency room and hospital. This can help you save time, and there's less of a chance of getting surprise bills in the mail — so it can help you save money, too.**

Your care team gets to know your health history and what tests you've had. They can also spot gaps in your care and help you get your care plan back on track.

For example, if you have a condition and need further care, here's how your care team may support you:

- Your primary care doctor may write you a prescription and refer you to a specialist in your Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic network.
- Your care team nurse can show you how to use and measure your medicine.
- If you forget to fill your prescription, your care team may call you.

Your care team may also refer you to support programs where you'll have a nurse care manager to help you.

Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic network providers can:

- Help keep you healthy and improve your health, not just treat you when you're sick or injured
- Coordinate your care and keep tabs on your prescriptions, lab results, health history and more
- Spot problems and build personalized care plans to treat you
- Encourage you to play an active, informed role in your health and health care decisions
- Help you save time and money by cutting down on unnecessary care and costs

- *Under your Aetna Whole Health[™] plan, if your primary care doctor is part of an integrated delivery system, your doctor and other integrated delivery system providers will generally refer you to specialists and hospitals that are affiliated with that delivery system. However, Aetna Whole Health providers that aren't part of the integrated network may not coordinate your care, and the data may not be shared in the manner described.
- **Aetna Whole Health Cleveland Clinic members are not required to choose a primary care physician (PCP), but are encouraged to do so. Aetna Whole Health Cleveland Clinic members DO NOT need a referral from their PCP to see a specialist.

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What's included?

Through the Aetna Whole Health[™] — Cleveland Clinic plan, you will have direct access to Cleveland Clinic's clinical team and their Navigators.

Your clinical team:

- Coordinates all of your care across all Cleveland Clinic providers and locations
- Helps with communication, accessing and sharing your medical record (including tests) with all your care providers
- Cares for you along a defined care path of the highest levels of success

Your Navigators:

- Welcome you to the Cleveland Clinic and reach out with everything you need to get connected to your circle of care. Aetna Whole Health members will receive a direct phone number to the Navigators.
- Introduce you to your primary care provider and set up your appointments.
- Remove the complexity of getting the right care at the right time.
- Connect with you based on your preferences email, mail, call, virtual, MyChart, etc.
- · Provide centralized financial and claims issue resolution.
- · Link you with your benefits.

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Frequently asked questions

Q: How's this plan different from other plans?

A: First, you'll have access to a special network of primary care doctors, specialists and hospitals focused on you. Your care team will work with you to help keep you healthy or improve your health.

Second, like other health plans, your Aetna Whole HealthSM doctors and hospitals get a fee for their services. Under the Aetna Whole Health plan, they can also earn more rewards when they meet certain goals. But if they fall short on those goals, they'll make less.

Third, we may share some of your health information with your Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic providers securely, in compliance with applicable law. The extra data can help them make parts of your care work better. And it can also cut down on duplicate tests or doctor visits that can add to your costs. However, providers who aren't part of the integrated network might not coordinate your care. Also, the data may not be shared in the way described above.

Q: How does it work?

A: First, choose a primary care doctor to lead your Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic care team.* Your doctor and other health care providers will generally refer you to specialists and hospitals in your network.

Then, electronic health records can help keep you and your care team on the same page. That's because they can keep track of your prescriptions, lab results, health history and more. Having a big-picture view of your health can help them spot gaps in your care. If they find that you're at risk for certain conditions, they can build you a personalized care plan.

Q: How do I know if my current primary care doctor is in the Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic network?

A: Visit **Aetna.com**** and enter your ZIP code to search for a doctor. Then follow the instructions to search for doctors and facilities.

If your primary care doctor isn't listed in the Aetna Whole Health — Cleveland Clinic network, don't worry. Our Member Services team and your Cleveland Clinic Navigator can help you choose a new doctor to lead your care team once you're enrolled.
